Technical Guidelines for Oral Presentation (Pre-recorded Video)

Please read the guidelines carefully for your preparation.

Pre-recorded Video for Oral Presentation

Your pre-recorded video will be displayed during a designated [Parallel Breakout Session](#) during the APRU Global Health Conference 2021, followed by a Q&A session. ALL presenting authors are required to show up virtually at the Q&A sessions.

Please read the requirements and regulations below before recording your video:

Video Specifications

- Length: 8-10 minutes, maximum 10 minutes
- Language: English
- Format: .mp4 or .mov
- Minimum video resolution: 1280x720 pixels

Requirements

- Please state the following items on the 1st presentation slide:
 - Paper number
 - Abstract title
 - Full name of presenting author

Video Recording

Please follow the step-by-step guide “Guideline for Pre-recording Your Presentation” to record your video.

Regulations

- Only one video is allowed for each accepted abstract.
- All personal data relating to personal information, e.g. patient and/or examination (e.g. date, time, place, patient name, patient birth date, unique ID, examiner name or ID, institution), must be removed from videos before submission.
- The video must not include racism, discrimination, or any libelous or defamatory content. It must not violate any laws/regulations.
- Material presented in videos should not violate any copyright laws. If videos/figures/graphics/images have been taken from sources not copyrighted by the author, it is the author’s sole responsibility to secure the rights from the copyright holder in writing to reproduce those videos/figures/graphics/images for both worldwide print and web publication. All reproduction costs charged by the copyright holder must be borne by the author.
- Expenses associated with the submission and presentation of the video is the responsibility of the authors/presenters.
- The submitted videos will become the Conference Organiser’s property. They can be freely used in the context of APRU activities. Copyright still belongs to the creators.

- To ensure quality, video submissions will be reviewed by the organisers and dependent on quality will be accepted for the final programme of the virtual conference.
- Accepted abstracts of authors who fail to submit their videos by the deadline will not be included in the programme nor publication.
